

Off-roading



Off-roading is the activity of driving or riding a vehicle on unsurfaced roads or tracks, made of materials such as sand, gravel, riverbeds, mud, snow, rocks, and other natural terrain. Traveling on off-road terrains require vehicles capable of accommodating off-road driving such as All-terrain vehicle. These vehicles accommodate off road conditions with extended ground clearance, off-road tires and drive-train. Our company offer vehicles specifically meant for off-road use.

Mud volcanoes



Azerbaijan and its Caspian coastline are home to nearly 400 mud volcanoes, more than half the total throughout the continents. In 2001, one mud volcano 15 kilometers (9 mi) from Baku made world headlines when it suddenly started ejecting flames 15 metres (49 ft) high.[15]

In Azerbaijan, eruptions are driven from a deep mud reservoir which is connected to the surface even during dormant periods, when seeping water still shows a deep origin. Seeps have temperatures up to 2 °C (3.6 °F) - 3 °C (5.4 °F) above the ambient temperature.



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Visa

Visa upon arrival in International Airports of Azerbaijan can be obtained only by Turkish and Israel citizens. Citizens of other countries have to obtain visa before arrival through consulates of Azerbaijan around the world. To obtain tourist visa to Azerbaijan you will need an official Letter of Invitation (LOI) or Tourist Voucher from our travel agency. Procedures and prices are different and depend of citizenship and consulate location. Please contact with our managers at list 6 weeks before to arrange our visa to Azerbaijan.

Starting from March 2013 new procedure of electronic visa obtaining is applied. Procedure of obtaining of electronic visas is simple and has advantages like - lower cost, no need to visit embassies because all process goes online only, you keep your passport with yourself all the time, you get a visa to your e-mail as PDF attachment that you need just to print. With this type of electronic visa you can enter Azerbaijan at any border entry point (air, land, sea). Duration of e-visa is till 1 month.

Travel Insurance

Travel insurance is compulsory for all our customers. You should ensure that your policy covers you for medical expenses and repatriation.

Packing for your trip

Unfortunately it does occasionally happen that luggage does not always reach its destination on the same flight as its owner, or possibly it may be damaged in transit. If you are unlucky enough for this to occur, it is important that you file a PIR (Property Irregularity Report) with the airline before leaving the airport. This is essential when you come to make a claim either against the airline or from your travel insurance company

Luggage

Remember you are expected to carry your own luggage so don't overload yourself.

One main piece of baggage and daypack. Total allowance: **20 kg.**

Suggested Clothing and Equipment

Wear closed-toe shoes (such as tennis shoes or boots). Sandals and shoes with high heels are not recommended. Wear comfortable clothing – we recommend you shorts or jeans because temperature in high places can change quickly. In the cooler months (September – October) we suggest you bring a light sweater or jacket. Bring a hat & sunglasses & apply sunscreen before tour. Don't forget your camera, the photo opportunities are amazing and provide for long-lasting memories!

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Comments

While it is our intention to follow the itinerary printed, tours within Azerbaijan may be subject to change a bit. The infrastructure for tourism is still developing in this region.

You'll need some extra money to cover meals not included in the tour price, other sightseeing, souvenirs and items of a personal nature such as laundry. Approximately USD 30 per day per person.

Local food is not expensive and you can choose local national restaurants and small cafes to eat, approximate menu price for one person is from USD 10.

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
